

ADVENT CANDLE LIGHTING

R 1: Today we light the Third Candle of Advent, the Candle of *Joy*. This candle reminds us that real joy is not found in what we buy, but in the love God brings into our lives.

R 2: Scripture tells us, "The Word became flesh and made His dwelling among us." God's joy came close. God's joy came in person. God's joy came through presence, not possessions.

R 1: During Advent, we often feel the pressure to spend more, do more, and rush more. But the story of Jesus points us in a different direction. The greatest gift God gave was Himself.

R 2: When we give our time, our attention, our compassion, and our presence, we share the joy of Christ with the world.

All: As we light the Candle of Joy, we ask God to help us slow down, simplify, and give from the heart. May our joy come from Christ's nearness and our willingness to be present with others. (Light the candle.)
